Our **Supervised Independent Living** programs provides youth ages 16-21 in the child welfare or juvenile justice systems with a **safe place** to live and the **practical tools** to manage a household.

Services provided include:

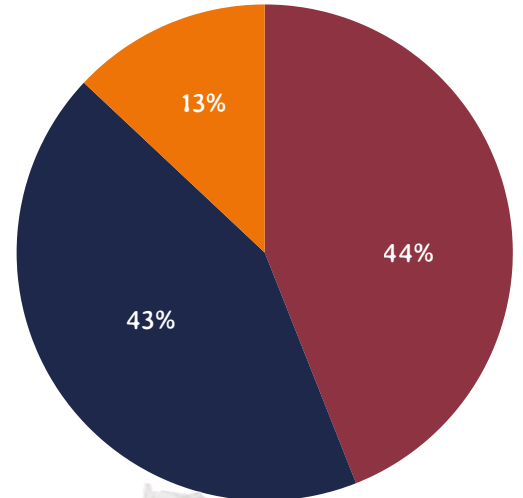
- **Housing:** Help finding apartments, navigating leases, and working with landlords.
- **Life Skills:** Practical training in daily living, social, educational, employment and self advocacy skills as well as financial literacy, civic engagement and navigation of the child welfare system.
- **Counseling & Parenting:** Access to individual therapy and parenting education.
- **Education & Community:** Year-round learning opportunities, summer recreational events, and peer support groups.

Program Satisfaction & Outcomes

84% of respondents learned life skills that helped them become **more independent**.

72% of youth improved or maintained **housing stability**.

94% of youth improved or maintained their **educational status**.

70% of youth **became employed** or **maintained employment** for 3 consecutive months.
